#### Qualifications

- Prefer a seasoned nursing educator with experience in teaching pathophysiology at either the baccalaureate or the advanced practice level.
- Will consider an advanced practice nurse with a graduate degree in nursing with documented course in advanced pathophysiology.
- Will consider a non-nurse who has a master's or doctorate degree in the life sciences or medical sciences; current Ph.D. seeking graduate students will also be considered.

- Nurse candidates must possess and maintain a current, unencumbered RN license to practice in Mississippi with no pending legal or State Board of Nursing actions.
