Faculty Position in Business Administration-Fashion – School of Business

Belhaven University, a Christian university committed to the ministry of integrating faith and learning, is searching for a candidate for a full-time professor in the School of Business to teach and provide leadership to our traditional fashion business degree program. Additional teaching responsibilities either on the traditional campus or online will depend on the applicant's qualifications. This position is based at the main campus in Jackson, Mississippi. This is an open-rank, tenure-track position.

Belhaven is located in a historic residential neighborhood just north of downtown Jackson. Jackson is a pleasant city with parks, bike trails, and a thriving arts and cultural community. The School of Business values strong partnerships within the community and within the university. Current faculty are collaborative and collegial with other departments working together on research, recruitment, and other projects.

Responsibilities

- Responsibilities include teaching traditional courses in the Fashion Business degree program.
- Responsibilities include teaching online courses in an area related to the applicant's qualifications.
- Candidates are expected to be consistently involved in scholarly activity, write or revise curriculum, attend residencies for online students, and participate in departmental activities that foster community.

Required Qualifications

- A Ph.D. or other doctorate in Business Administration, Marketing, Textiles, Design, Consumer Affairs, or another closely-related discipline is required.
- A record of fashion industry work experience in an executive role is preferred, but not required.

- A CV and cover letter outlining your suitability for this position, including an explanation of your interest in Christian higher education.
- A 3 to 4 paragraph statement of how you would integrate the Biblical worldview into all instructional content.
